Make a Pine Cone Bird Feeder!

Feed the birds using supplies you already have at home and in your yard

Materials

- Pinecones
- String, hemp, yarn, or thick thread
- Peanut butter
- Bird seed or uncooked quinoa & oats or unsalted nuts

Steps

- 1. Find pinecones in your yard or local park
- 2. Tie a string, hemp, yard, or thick thread around the top of the pinecone. Create a loop on the other end to hang from a branch
- 3. Spread peanut butter on the pinecone, making sure to get in all the nooks and crannies
- 4. Roll the pinecone in bird seed, uncooked quinoa, uncooked oats, unsalted nuts (walnuts are great), or any combination of these ingredients



- 5. Hang pinecone outside on a branch
- 6. Enjoy birdwatching!
